DIPLOMA IN MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNOLOGY (DMLT)

Approved by State Paramedical Faculty, Lucknow
Registered with Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Govt. of India

Objective of the course:

To equip the candidate to carry out routine diagnostic and therapeutic tests in a modern hospital laboratory.

Eligibility for admission:

- Candidates belonging to all categories should have passed intermediate (10+2) from UP board/other boards/university /equivalent.
- *Should have taken English as a compulsory subject in intermediate level.*
- **Age limit:** Candidate should have completed the age of 17 years at the time of admission or would complete the said age on or before 31st December of the year of admission to the course.
- Upper age limit is 35 years at time of admission.

Method of selection:

Candidates will have to sit for written test.

Qualifying candidates in the written test will be interviewed by the selection committee. The decision of the selection committee will be final.

All the selected candidates have to undergo compulsory medical checkup in Broadwell Christian Hospital Fatehpur. Medical checkup Fee to be paid in cash Rs. 1500.00

After clearance in medical checkups, candidates have to undergo orientation for 12 days at Broadwell Christian Hospital.

Orientation fee of Rs.1500/- should be paid in cash before the commencement of curriculum.

Final Merit List

Final Merit list will be declared once a candidate successfully completes Written Test, Interview, Medical Test & Orientation.

Seat reservation:

Selected candidate should pay by cash Rs. 1000 as seat reservation fee. It is non refundable and valid for one week from date of declare final merit list.

Attendance of students:

The student should have 75% attendance in theory and 100% attendance in practical to be eligible to appear in Paramedical faculty examination.

Total Course Duration:

- The course is of two years and is a full time course.
Maximum duration permissible to complete the course will be double the duration of regular course, that is no candidate will be allowed to go beyond four years once enrolled for the course.

Curriculum:

The curriculum and the syllabus for the course shall be as prescribed by the State Paramedical Faculty, Lucknow (SPMFL).

Medium of instruction and examination:

In case of diploma courses the medium of instruction will be bilingual (English or Hindi) and the medium of examination will be either English or Hindi as per the convenience of the student.

At the end of first year, an Internal examination will be conducted at the college level itself and the result sent to the SPMFL.

Passing Marks of Examination:

- The passing marks of examination would be 50% for each subject and also in total marks obtained.
- The candidate should pass separately in two heads i.e. In Theory (Theory plus Viva voice plus Internal Assessment) and also in Practical (with 50% marks).
- If a candidate fails in either theory or practical examinations, he/she has to reappear for both (theory and practical).

Important rules regarding the entrance examination:

- Candidates who wish to apply for the course should fill and submit the given application form and attach one recent self attested photo.
- There will be only one question paper containing 100 questions of intermediate level and general knowledge. The question paper will be given in Hindi or English; Questions will be of multiple choice type. The candidate has to choose the correct option. In case of unclear marking of answers or in case of selection of more than one answer by the candidate, the answer shall be taken as incorrect. There is no negative marking system.
- The admission time for the candidate in the examination centre will be from 11:00 am on the day of exam. Doors of the examination hall shall be opened at 10:30 am.
- Candidates must enter the examination hall by 10:30 am. Under no circumstance will the candidate be given entry into the examination hall after 10:30 am.
- After entry into the examination hall, the candidate will be required to fill entries in the answer booklet.
- At the end of the examination, the candidate may leave the examination hall quietly after handing over the answer sheet along with the question paper.
- Candidate may have to undergo various security checks, at examination centre. This process is mandatory and if the candidate refuses, his/her candidature may be cancelled.
- Carrying or using a calculator, digital diary, log table, laptop, notebook, pager, or cellular phone, Bluetooth, electronics watch or any other gadgets, books, paper, notes etc, at examination centre will amount to unfair means. If candidate is found indulging in unfair means, his/her candidature shall be cancelled.

Admit card

- Admit card can be obtained from the Principal Office from 9 AM on the day of examination.
- No candidate will be allowed entry into the examination hall without a valid admit card, so keep it securely.

Exam Results and Merit List

- After the entrance examination, the results of the candidates will be declared.
- The final merit list will be declared based on the performance in both the entrance examination and interview and will be put up on notice board. The result will not be communicated via post, email, or in person.
- Candidates whose names have appeared in the merit list will have to come for admission along with original certificates will be retained by lab school and a set of self- attested photocopy of the same.

Admission policy:

1. Admission to the courses will be on the basis of a written exam and interview.
2. The written exam will be in multiple choice (MCQ) format. Questions will be asked to test knowledge of the candidates in Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Math's, English and Hindi.
3. Shortlisted candidates from the written exam will be called for interview. The interview will be held by a panel, and will assess the candidate in multiple areas including knowledge, aptitude, skills, worldviews and belief systems.
4. School of Paramedical Training is run by Broadwell Christian Hospital, a Christian minority institution, serving the needy and marginalized sections of the society. In line with this policy, the selection panel may, at their discretion; give weightage to certain sections of students which may includes, but is not limited to:
 - a) Students from poor socioeconomic background.
 - b) Absent or poor social support systems -e.g. orphans, single parents, parents who are not working due to chronic illness etc.
 - c) Christian minority background.
5. The decision of the selection panel will be final.
6. The final shortlisted candidates have to compulsory undergo medical checkup.
7. These candidates will undergo a period of Pre-training orientation of 2 weeks. Enrollment to course will be finalized only after successful completion of orientation.

Registration for Admission

Those finally selected for admission will be required to register for the course by paying the tuition fee and completing other admission formalities. Students should submit their certificates in ORIGINAL. Admission to the DMLT diploma course will continue to be provisional until approval by the SPMFL.

Hostel rules:

1. Candidates admitted to the course will be offered hostel accommodation, subject to availability of seats. Hostel inmates have to take mess membership compulsorily. Self
2. Hostel and mess fees must be paid in quarterly installments at the beginning of each quarter.
3. Inmates must report to the respective warden.
4. Outing not allowed after 6.30 pm.
5. At the time of final admission, parents/guardians must give the name and photo of 2 people they permit to visit their candidate in the school premises. In the event of anyone coming to visit, the same must be informed before hand to the hostel warden/School principal through proper channel.
6. No visitors will be encouraged in the hostel room at any cost without explicit permission from the hostel warden and School principal.
7. In the event of any damage to hostel property, the same will be recovered from the student.
8. Inmates are not allowed to spend time in the hostel room during classroom hours except during lunch break.

General instructions for students:*

Students are instructed to abide by the rules and regulation, listed below laid down by the management of Broadwell Christian Hospital and School of Paramedical Training.

1. Classrooms and campus discipline should be strictly maintained by student, breach of discipline and negligence in the part of the students may lead to dismissal from the school.
2. Students are instructed to wear prescribed uniform regularly. Valid reason should be given in case of students fails to attend class in proper uniform.
3. Use of mobile/tablets/or any other gadgets during class /study/test/exam hours are strictly prohibited. if found gadgets during class/ study/test/exam hours, it may lead to confiscation of the gadget for the session and shall be returned only after the end of academic session.
4. In case of need of leave, proper procedure laid by the school management should be followed. All the leaves should be sanctioned by Principal/vise-Principal, beforehand. Leave without sanction will be considered as absence and it may affect the attendance percentage.
5. Visitors are discouraged during class/study hours, unless it is in the discretion of the Principal/vise- Principal to allow or disallow visitors.
6. During admission, list of authorized visitors- maximum two in number – with photo and ID should be submitted with the principal’s office. This is applicable for both boarders as well as day- scholars.
7. For boarders, no stay-over, visitors are allowed. No visitors are allowed to visit the hostel room.
8. Students are encouraged to participate in hospital activities conducted in the campus.
9. Students are expected to display manners and politeness towards their class mates, juniors, faculty, school management and hospital staff/families. Foul language, provocative and inappropriate gestures, shall be taken as breach of discipline and dealt accordingly.
10. No sexually harassing comments, gestures, symbols and contents display or any such other things that may be of harassing nature to the opposite sex, shall not be tolerated, and the students indulged in such activities, if proven guilty, shall be categorically dismissed and no refunds shall be made on account of fee deposited.
11. We strictly follow Anti-Ragging policy, and if anyone found to be involved with ragging, action shall be taken as per the rules set by the law against ragging in school/college/institutions.
